Young Mothers Harvesting

It is both exciting and encouraging to see that the young mothers we support have finally begun to reap the rewards of their hard work. After patiently waiting for over 3 months, they have started harvesting their horticulture crops on their 1 acre plot located at the FFF farm. This 1 acre horticulture plot which has recently been incorporated into the Yara Knowledge Centre is a training plot for these young mothers. After 2 years of training, they jointly work together to put a crop in the field, manage it until harvest, seek customers and sell their produce to raise an income.



This remarkable achievement was made possible thanks to the unwavering support of our partners: SAGCOT, who provided the greenhouse that served as a nursery, Yara Tanzania, who offered fertilizers and other nutrition together with essential crop nutrition guidance, and Seed Co Tanzania, who supplied the high-quality seeds together with agronomic support.

The success of this tomato project is a testament to the power of collaboration and the transformative impact we can have when we work together towards a common goal.
