FFF Investors supporting the FFF Mission to more Sustainability

We are thrilled to share some exciting news about the progress we're making at FFF towards our goal of sustainable farming focusing on ensuring the availability of water at the farm.

For the very first time our rainwater dam is finally full to the brim. This means we can now look forward to a bountiful winter crop of sugar beans and potato seeds under irrigation, while still having ample water to kickstart the new season for our seed maize. This is one of our best achievements this season and it will contribute very positively to our cash flow.

To ensure full dam in May every year, FFF will now invest in a larger pumping system that pumps surplus water from the nearest temporary river during the approx. 20 days when it rains significantly. Also boreholes on the farm will be established to gain more water. An investment of 200.000 USD is now planned for pumping, boreholes and more storage for water. With a full dam, the farm can be planted twice (the second under the irrigation system), which today covers 120 ha.



Very positive feedback on the work being done.

Our recent event at Saltbua på Hellvik in Norway with over 100 FFF supporters from different places in Norway was a resounding success. We were overwhelmed by the positive feedback and comments, especially from the investors who have already had the chance to visit our farm.

Their firsthand experience has shown them the true potential of our farm, and we're now encouraging more investors and supporters from outside of Tanzania to follow in their footsteps. There's nothing quite like seeing our operation in person to fully appreciate the remarkable strides we're making.

During the event, new possible supporters/shareholders were invited to the meeting, including the Mayor of Eigersund Municipality. Who commended the FFF team for the work done.
